EMERGENCY PLAN

Funding for the operation of Transit comes from Section 5311, from South Dakota Department of Transportation; Title III, Office of Adult Services and Aging; United Way, Contracts with Agencies served in Huron, Fares and Donations from riders.

Objective:

People's Transit is committed to the Beadle County Area to provide safe reliable public transportation for its' citizens. We also wish to make vehicles available to the Community in time of emergency.

Plan:

Vehicle's in the Transit fleet range in size from 11 passenger to 25 passenger. Some are equipped with hydraulic lifts, for riders not able to board the bus using the steps.

The Mayor of Huron, City Administrator, or Emergency Manager, may call an emergency, therefore, Transit would make as many vehicles available as possible, at the given time of the emergency. Some samples are: having availability to Firemen to warm up during a fire, evacuation of buildings or area for flood victims and other weather related incidents.

People's Transit Office (353-0100) should be called Monday through Friday, 8:00 am until 5:00 pm. After these hours and on weekends, phone calls can be made to the following designated people in the order of listing, until one of the staff persons listed are contacted.

1. Gayle Kludt
2. Stephany Weed

Because of emergency situations, Transit may not have staff available at all times a vehicle is needed. In these situations, Huron City employees would be eligible to drive the buses under Transit insurance policy providing drug and alcohol regulations have been followed.
